

## 2018 NCRS Texas Chapter Meet, Austin TX

The Texas Chapter NCRS will host a Barbecue Dinner and Chapter Meet on Friday & Saturday, May 11 & 12, 2018. The Barbecue Dinner will be hosted by Tim and Mary Gilmore at their home at 7012 Oak Shores Drive, Austin, TX 78730 from 6:00 – 10:00PM.

We will be holding the Flight Judging in the shop of Carl Everett at 3209 Neidhardt Drive, Austin, TX 78732. This location is near the intersection of General Williamson Drive and Highway 360. General Williamson Drive is located about 1.5 before Mansfield Dam if you're traveling Northeast on Hwy 360. You can only turn Southwest on General Williamson Drive. Neidhardt Drive is about ¼ mile to the left after you turn on General Williamson Drive (just past the fire station). Please don't block any of the fire department exits. Carl's shop is about 100 yards after you turn left on Neidhardt Drive.

Trailer parking will be at Hudson Bend Middle School, 15600 Lariat Trail, Austin, TX 78734. The middle school is located right across the street from the fire station and within walking distance from Carl's shop.

For those that are not able to register-line there is an attached registration form with appropriate mailing instructions.

Flight Judging will be limited to 4 cars (one C4) at each of the Chapter meets. There is no limit on the number of Sportsman Display cars.

All cars registered for Austin/San Antonio Chapter Meet will be positioned on the judging field at 9:00 AM. A Judges meeting will be held at 9:00 AM followed by an Owners meeting at 9:10 AM. Ops check judging will begin immediately following the Owners meeting. Note: The cold start check will be waived for this meet. All Cars must remain on the judging field until released at 3:00 PM on Saturday.

In order to have sufficient judges to make this event a success, we ask that all owners serve as a judge. Chapter members not entering a car in the meet are urged to judge. Realizing that some of you may be a novice judge, our intent is to pair you with a more experienced judge. Judges will earn 2 points for this event.

There will be a sign-in sheet at the NCRS display that should be signed by all Texas Chapter members. If possible, please drive a Corvette to the event in order to help satisfy the Top Flight Chapter Award requirement.

Awards will be presented at the completion of the judging on Saturday.
