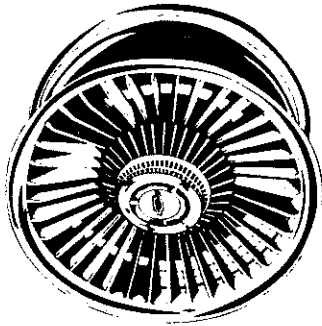
The date for the event will remain the first available week-end in May. Mickey Phair will check on availability and make necessary commitments.

Meeting adjourned at 10:23 pm

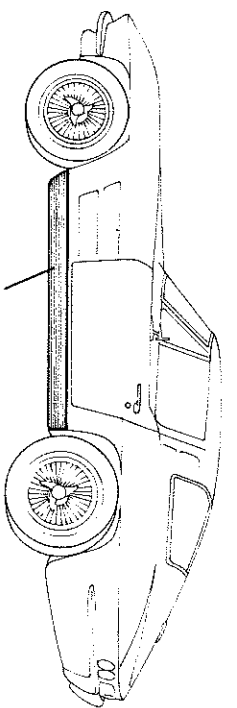

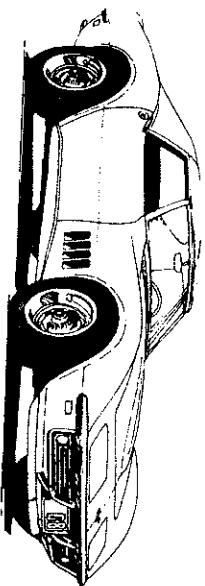

New Braunfels Texas was the site of the NCRS Texas Chapter State Meet May 1-3. The meetings were held at the Holiday Inn, with the judging and swap meet at the Wurstfest grounds and hall. This was the fourth meet held at New Braunfels and all present enjoyed the best weather and event to date.

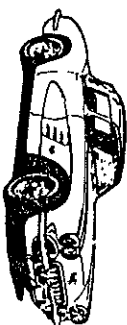
Friday May 1st involved registration, an evening pre-show driver judges meeting, and the usual parking lot sessions. Saturday saw early activity, as the Corvettes were prepared for the parade thru downtown New Braunfels to the Wurstfest Hall. Mickey Phair (meet chairman) led approximately 25 Corvettes plus support vehicles to the show area. Judging Chairman, Jerry Elrod kept a close watch on over-cast skys, tossed a coin and the Corvettes were set up outside the hall, with the parts vendors just inside the hall. 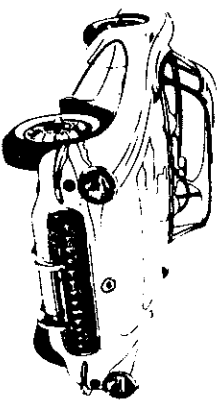

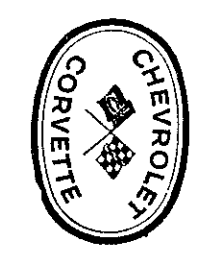
