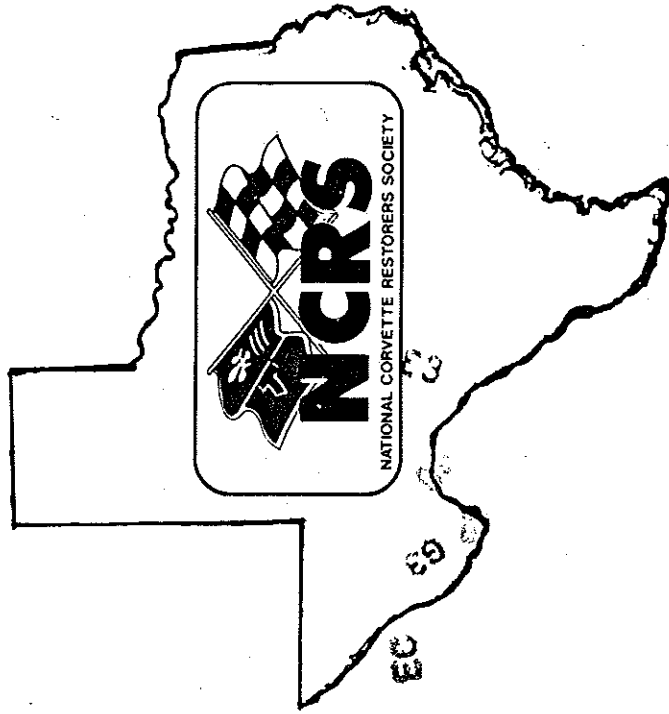


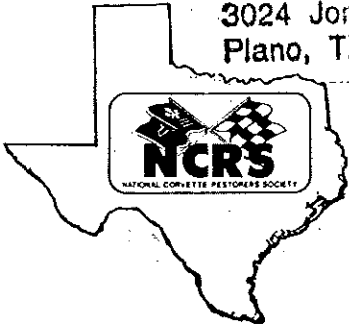

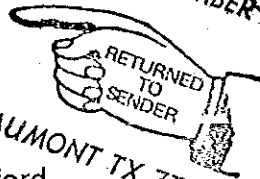

From the President

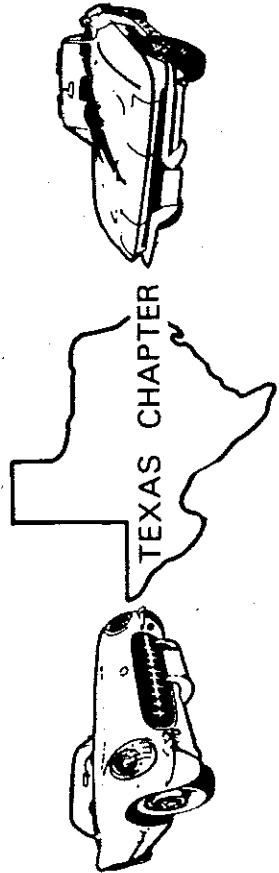

MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING OF THE NATIONAL CORVETTE RESTORERS SOCIETY - TEXAS CHAPTER

1. Time and Place

The annual meeting of the National Corvette Restorers Society - Texas Chapter, a Texas corporation, was held at the George Brown Convention Center, in Houston, Texas, on February 23, 1991, at the hour of 2:00 p.m., for the purpose of considering reports of the affairs of the corporation, and transacting other business within the powers of the Members.

2. Call to Order - Chairman and Secretary

The meeting was called to order by John Smart, President of the corporation. As authorized by the Bylaws, the President presided as Chairman of the meeting and Franklin L. Tuttle, Jr., Secretary of the corporation, acted as secretary of the meeting and recorded the minutes.

3. Validity of Meeting

The meeting being held in accordance with the terms of the Bylaws of the corporation, the chairman declared that the meeting was lawfully and properly convened.

4. Officers

The Chairman then introduced the officers as follows:

5. Tyler Meet

The Chairman asked for any discussion concerning the meet to be held in Tyler on May 17 through May 19, 1991. Bruce Knierim reported the number of cars and participants currently registered. John Smart encouraged attendance and participation.

A question was asked about what qualifies as "proof of insurance" for judging. Discussion indicated that a proof of insurance card is not usually adequate, unless it has details of the liability coverage, and the vehicle identification number of the car being judged. If these details are not on the proof of insurance card, the policy will be required.

6. Region 7 Director

Roby Price, our Region 7 Director of NCRS, reported that NCRS membership is up overall. He also reported that there is a dues increase for the first time in four years.

Roby reported that the judging manual revisions should be complete by mid-1992, hopefully in time for the NCRS National Convention in 1992.

The NCRS National Convention is to be held in Anaheim, California this summer. From an earlier trip to Anaheim, Roby reported that the facilities are excellent and should allow NCRS to have an excellent show and convention. Roby also asked for the support of the Texas Chapter for his re-election to another term as the Region 7 Director. Roby indicated that he would like to see the mid-year judging manual revisions to their completion.

7. Annual Report
 The Chairman then called on Bruce Knierim, who presented to the meeting the Annual Report of the corporation for the year ended December 31, 1990. The report showed that the club had 77 paid members for 1990, and \$1,961.75 in the bank as of December 31, 1990.

8. Newsletter
 John Smart reported that H.B. Nutt had officially retired as publisher-editor of the "Tailpipe". John Smart asked for volunteers. Lee Hagewood volunteered, but asked for contributions from members for the newsletter.

9. Roster
 A new roster will be published soon.

10. Future Meetings
 John Smart reported that the Texas Chapter would have a business meeting in June at Bloomington, Illinois, and a fall meeting at Wichita Falls.

11. Corvette Museum
 Mr. Bob Johnson who was in attendance at the meeting reported that the deadline for becoming a founder of the Corvette Museum had been extended to August 31, 1991. There are currently about 3500 members. It is estimated that there will need to be 15,000 members each contributing \$100.00 before General Motors will show any interest in participating.

12. Resolutions
 Upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, it was:
RESOLVED, that all proceedings of the Board of Directors since the last meeting of the Shareholders and all acts taken by members of the Board of Directors or by officers of this corporation, are hereby ratified and approved in all respects.

13. Adjournment
 On motion duly made and carried, there being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

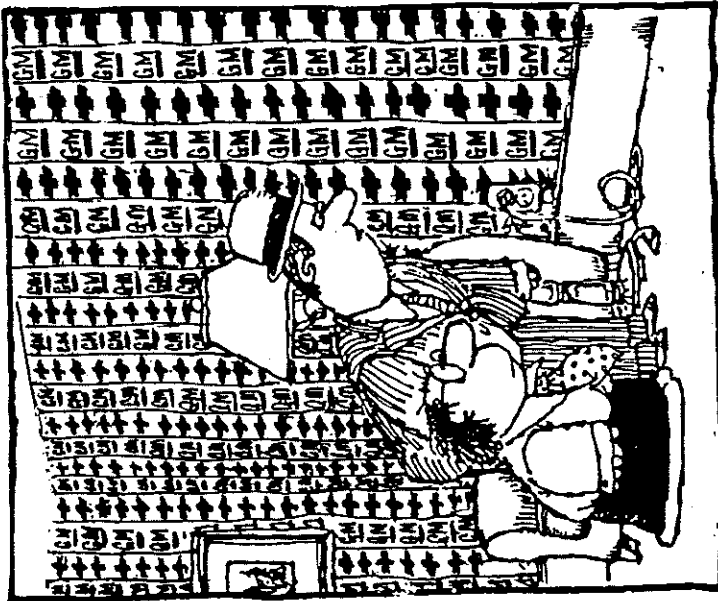

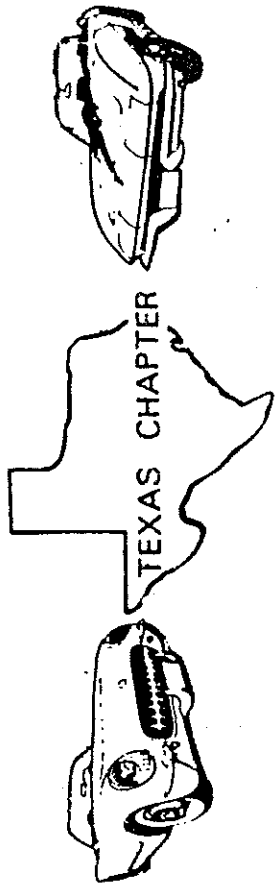

FLIGHT JUDGING INFORMATION

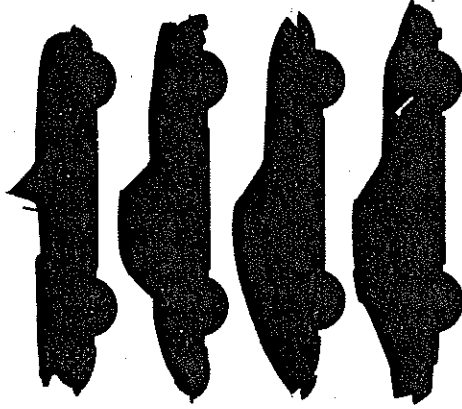
- Cars are to be moved into building on Friday from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm and
